

## Archery Club Practice Plans

- Members
  - An estimate of 8 members
  
- Social Distancing Measures
  - Masks will be required at all practices.
  - Members must wash their hands before and after practice.
  - Each member will have a bale to themselves and bales will be separated to allow for social distancing.
  - Those waiting for their turn will be waiting on the side, six feet apart and be called on for their turn.
  - As Archery is a noncontact sport, there will be no contact at all during practices.
  - Any individual who violates the aforementioned rules will be given two warnings
    - After two warnings, consequences such as a practice ban or other measure may be enacted depending on the severity of the warnings (i.e. standing a little too close vs. direct contact)
  
- Responsibilities
  - Equipment
    - One set of equipment will be assigned to exactly one member each practice. Before and after each practice, officers will wipe down all equipment used.
    - Arrows, bows, and arm guards will be provided by the executive officers.
  - Check-ins
    - A Google form will be used to keep track and serve as a back-up of check-ins for each player during practice by the officer present.
    - The president is responsible for check-ins. If unable to attend practice, the third officer is responsible for check-ins. If both the president and third officer are unavailable, then the treasurer will be responsible for check-ins.
    - All members must be on the Archery Club's roster on the Club Management page. The officer responsible for check-in must mark them off on the website before being allowed to practice.
  - Wellness checks for symptoms of COVID-19 will be conducted on each of the members before allowing them to enter the practice area.
  - A Google form will be used to log the daily wellness of members and any interaction with a COVID-positive individual (if there is an issue noticed, we will update them on proper quarantine procedure and will not allow them in practice)

- o Social Distancing: Each member is responsible for keeping a 6-foot distance from others at all times, however, officers will also be responsible for reminding members as well with warnings.
